Why laptops?

- * Compatibility with school network
- Ability to use specialist programs
- * Aligns with university / workplace expectations

Device requirements

BYOD laptops must:

- o Be able to access the internet
- o Run Microsoft Office suite
- o Have physical storage

Specialist subjects:

Subjects requiring specialist software will be timetabled in computer labs – i.e. Arts, IT, Graphics (Adobe, Inventor, etc.)








To install the apps, please select the **Windows icon** at the bottom left hand corner of the screen, and then open the **Company Portal application**.

Protection - Physical

- * Devices must be kept with students at all times.
- * Secure storage arrangements are available when this is not suitable e.g. sport
- * Devices should are covered in a 'tough' case.
- * Families are strongly encouraged to have insurance and warranty / ADP on personal devices.

Protection - Online

- Students are only permitted to access the internet using the EQ network
- * Students only communicate with staff and students using EQ email
- All EQ networks, sites and systems are protected, filtered and monitored
- * 3/4G must be disabled on all devices
- * Anti-virus software must installed
- * Students are explicitly taught about cyber safe practices
- * Access to safe sites only at school
